Respected Sir/Madam,

On the basis of your application and the subsequent correspondence with the school and inspection thereunder:

I, the Education Officer (Primary), Zilla Parishad, Aurangabad, hereby grant approval, w.e.f. 16/06/2014, for the Std. I to V from the year 2014-15 to the school - Zulekha Motiwala Social Welfare

Charitable Trust, Nirala Bazar, Aurangabad Pearls Academy School,
Gut No. 81.82, Sawangi, Tq & Dist. Aurangabad, for Higher Primary
(Std. VI to VIII), Medium – English,

The approval is subject to following conditions:

1. The period of approval cannot be increased and no binding whatsoever, in any situation will be for granting approval or affiliation after Std. VIII.

2. The School shall follow the provisions made in the Children's Right for Free and Compulsory Education Act , 2009 (Annexure I) and Children's Right for Free and Compulsory Education (Maharashtra) Rules, 2011 (Annexure II)

3. The school shall admit the children belonging to the weak and deprived sections nearby the school, in standard I, to the extent of 25% min.of the total strength and shall provide free and compulsory education to those children. Notwithstanding to this, this standard will be followed for the pre-primary standards also.

4. The school shall receive compensation for the children mentioned in para. 3 vide section 12(2). The school will be provided a separate bank account for such compensation.

5. The School/institution shall not recover any capitation fees and not insist children or their parents to undergo for any scrutiny.

6. No child shall be denied the admission in the school on the grounds of religion, caste or race or place of birth or any of this and in absence of proof of age.

7. (One) Any child once admitted shall not be kept in the same standard or shall not be removed from the school till the completion of primary education.

(Two) No child should be given physical punishment or mental torture.

(Three) No child shall be required to pass any examination of any board till the completion of primary education.

(Four) Every child having completed the primary education shall be given a certificate vide Rule 23.



(Five) The physically challenged/special pupils shall be included as per the provisions of the Act:

(Six) The teachers having min. qualification as prescribed under the Section 23(1) of the Act shall be appointed; Notwithstanding this, the teachers having not qualified on the date of beginning of the Act shall be required to obtain such a qualification within 5 years.

(Seven) The teachers shall fulfill their duties as given in the Section 24(1) and

(Eight) The school shall ensure that the teachers are not engaged in private tuitions.

8. The School shall follow the curriculum based on the text prepared by an appropriate authority.

9. The School shall admit such number of students as per the facilities available in the section 19.

10. Following facilities were available in the School during last inspection as specified in the Section 19 of the School Act.

11. The classes or standards not approved cannot be run in the premises of school or elsewhere.



12. The building of the school or other constriction or playground shall be used only for education or skill development purposes.

13. The school is being run by as society registered under the Societies Registration Act. 1860 (21 of 1860) or the Maharashtra Public Trusts Act, 1950.

14. The school is not run for the financial or other benefit of any person or group of persons.

15. The accounts of the school should be audited by a chartered accountant and proper audit statements be made. A copy of each statement shall be sent to the Education Officer every year.

16. The approval code for your school is (27191000137). Kindly mention the same while making any correspondence with this office.

17. Any such report or information as will be required by the Director of Education or Dist. Education Officer shall be provided by the school or the instructions of the local authority shall be followed for compliance of the conditions of approval or to remove the lacunae in the functioning of the school.

18. Renewal should be ensured, if any, regarding the registration of the school.

19. Annexure III giving other terms is enclosed herewith.

20. This approval is granted subject to condition that, deficiencies shown in inspection report shall be complied with by 31/03/2015.

21. On the prominent location of school building the plank visibly displaying 'Self-financed school' shall be compulsorily fixed.

22. Management should not run the school out of profit motive.

23. For raising donation funds, fixed deposit receipt shall be given in the custody of District Education Officer towards lien, and such receipt shall be of any of the nationalized bank given in Schedule 'G'.
